



TEN *MORE* FUN ACTIVITIES WITH SWITCH ADAPTED TOYS

1. Get Crafty

Crafting teaches skills while igniting creativity and joy.

[Adapted Battery Operated Scissors #9080](#) can be used with children and adults, and the creative possibilities are endless.

2. Enjoy a Light Show

[Magical Light Show #1672](#) is fun for all ages and abilities. Use the built-in

switch or connect an external switch to turn the show on and off. Magical Light Show offers stimulating light, sound and vibration for a concert-like experience!

3. Have a Sing-Along

Pretend you're at Disney World as you sing along with [Singing Fun Mickey #9416](#) & [Sparkle & Sing Minnie #9415](#). Little hands and new switch users could benefit from using the [Jumbo Switch #787R](#) with either of these adapted toys.



4. Play a Carnival Game

Our switch-activated [High Striker #2242](#), a miniature version of a popular carnival game, is great fun by yourself or with a friend. The vertical light track and stimulating spinning glitter assists with visual regard/visual tracking goals and hand strength goals.



5. Hold a Tetherball Championship

Take turns grabbing the [Pull Ball #416](#) and watch it light up and play music. This toy is popular with OTs, as it teaches hand skills, strength, and cause and effect through play! It requires only a slight force to turn it on, increasing the chances of success on the first try.

6. **Make It a Beach Day!** [Harbor Breeze #3288](#) checks all of the boxes to facilitate visual skills, cause and effect play, and tactile processing. Bring vacation vibes to a classroom or program group activity by incorporating a water play station, sand dig station, vacation smells station (various scented lotions or sunscreen) and island beats station using [Bongo Drums #756](#).

7. Play School

Be the teacher with [Alphabet Jodey #9351](#). Be the bus driver with [Wheellie #9323](#) or the classroom pet with [Baby Retriever #889](#).

8. Land on the Moon

Play astronaut with our NASA replica [Space Shuttle R/C #5060](#). Use a black sheet or a black trifold board to create an outer space backdrop. Little astronauts may also enjoy [Rocket Dream Ship #9339](#).

9. Make Music

With our new [Music Master #2219](#), you can create unique sounds by yourself, or improvise with others using one's personal switch. Each press of one's personal switch plays a new note within the programmed collection of harmonic possibilities in the software. The device includes controls for volume, reverb and delay, just like a real amplifier, and includes a jack for headphones.

10. Play Red Light, Green Light 1-2-3

In this version of the classic game, players take turns being the leader who activate the Traffic Light #1810 switches: Activation of the green switch means players move their bodies; yellow, they slow down; and red, they stop moving. Make this a fun gross motor group activity, fun for all levels.
